

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) of JKSET-LASET: 2026

Q1. Do I need to submit a hard copy of the application form before the exam?

No. There is **no need to submit hard copies** before the exam. Only qualified candidates will need to submit documents later.

Q2. What documents must be submitted after qualifying the exam?

Qualified candidates must submit:

- Application form (printout)
- Scorecard
- PG marksheet
- Domicile certificate (if applicable)
- Category certificate (if applicable)
- PwD certificate (if applicable)
- Bonafide certificate (if pursuing Master's)

Q3. What happens if my category certificate is invalid?

Your reserved category claim will be **rejected**, and your candidature may be cancelled. Fee will not be refunded.

Q4. Can I change my category later?

Yes, only during a correction window (if provided), you may opt for the General category if eligible.

Q5. How should the examination fee be paid?

Only through the **online payment gateway** on the application portal.

Q6. What should I keep after fee payment?

- Fee receipt
- Application form
- Transaction Reference Number

Q7. What is the mode of examination?

The exam is conducted in **offline mode**.

Q8. How many papers are there?

There are **two papers (Paper I & Paper II)**.

Q9. What type of questions are asked?

Objective type questions:

- Multiple choice
- Matching
- Assertion & Reasoning

Q10. Is it compulsory to appear in both papers?

Yes. If you miss Paper I, you cannot appear in Paper II.

Q11. Is there negative marking?

No. There is **no negative marking**.

Q12. What is the duration of the exam?

- Paper I: 1 hour
- Paper II: 2 hours
(with 20-minute gap)

Q13. In which language is the exam conducted?

- Paper I: English & Hindi
- Paper II: Mostly English (varies for language subjects)

Q14. What is the minimum qualifying percentage?

- General/EWS: 40%
- Reserved categories: 35%

Q15. How many candidates qualify?

Around **6% of candidates** who appear in both papers qualify.

Q16. Is re-evaluation allowed?

No. **Re-evaluation/re-checking is not allowed.**

Q17. Can I challenge the answer key?

Yes, within a specified time after provisional key release.

Q18. Is there a fee for challenging answers?

Yes, **₹200 per question**, non-refundable.

Q19. What documents must I carry to the exam center?

- Admit card
- Valid photo ID
- PwD certificate (if applicable)
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Q20. Are electronic devices allowed?

No. Mobile phones, calculators, and other gadgets are strictly prohibited.

Q21. Can I enter late?

No entry after **10 minutes** of exam start.

Q22. What happens in case of unfair means?

- Exam cancellation
- Possible debarment from future exams

Q23. What if someone impersonates a candidate?

Both persons will be disqualified and may face legal action.

Q24. Where are exam centers located?

Main centers are in **Kashmir, Jammu, and Ladakh.**

Q25. Will travel allowance (TA/DA) be provided?

No TA/DA will be paid.

Q26. How long are records preserved?

Records are kept for **90 days after result declaration.**
